Fireworks Outdoors	\$150 per event	Outdoor professional fireworks permit compliant with ATF inspection.
Fireworks – fire watch as required	\$150 per engine per hour plus fire watch	Fire Watch as required by the Fire Marshal. Fire watch fee, per firefighter of \$50 an hour is an additional charge to this fee.
Fireworks – Indoors	\$155 per event plus fire watch	Any use of fireworks indoors requires a fire watch for a minimum of 4 hours consisting of a minimum of one engine and four firefighters in addition to the \$150 fee.
Fireworks Stand	\$1,500 fee	Fees as declared and collected by Jefferson County or Lakewood. Douglas County Fee of \$1,500 collected by West Metro. Agency of collection requires fireworks enforcement officer during Independence Day Operational Period
Tents and Canopies	\$75 per event	Tents or canopies meeting the size requirements of the IFC 2003. Tents and membrane structures 200 sq. ft. and canopies in excess of 400 sq. ft.
Miscellaneous Combustible Storage	\$100 per year	Fee for storage of miscellaneous combustibles in business occupancies that is over 10,000 pounds that is not directly used inventory
Open Flame and Candles	N/C	Any facility that uses candles for any ceremony or display in business including religious occupancies and restaurant. All infrared and propane heaters shall be included.
Burn Permit--non-recreational	\$50 per burn season per area	Burns for slash and other rubbish
Temporary Access Road Agreement	\$75 per event	Any construction site or event that requires a temporary Access Roadway agreement for access restriction or a region in which Emergency Vehicle Access roadways are used less than the required width as approved by the Fire Marshal

Total Building Review	\$150 plus \$.75 per \$1,000 of dollars of job cost	Fee for construction permit for tenant finish or total building package. Fees based ICC fee standards for Colorado.
Building Tenant Finish Review Fee for small jobs. Jobs less than 3600 sq. ft.	\$75 plus \$.75 per \$1,000 of dollars of job cost	Fee for small tenant finish jobs of less than 3600 square feet or small fire detection and fire suppression systems. Jobs that require less than 5 component changes.
Tenant Finish over 3600 sq. ft.	\$150 plus \$.75 per \$1,000 of dollars of job cost	Fee for tenant space improvement including fire alarm and sprinkler review if received for total review. Fees are based on the ICC formula for construction minus the core and shell fee.
Fire Alarm	\$150 plus \$1.50 per component	Fire Alarm plans review and final inspection.
